The PMSBY offers accidental death-cum-disability insurance of Rs.2 lakhs to all bank account holders in the age group of 18-70 Years for an annual premium of Rs.12/- only. The PMJJBY offer a term life insurance cover of Rs.2 lakhs for an annual premium of Rs.330/- to all bank account holders in the age group of 18-50 years. APY promotes old age income security and focuses on unorganized sector works. It offers subscribers entering the scheme at the age between 18 and 40 years, a Govt. guaranteed minimum pension per month starting at the age of 60.

The premium under the above schemes is very nominal and the benefits accruing will go a long way in building additional social security for the families.

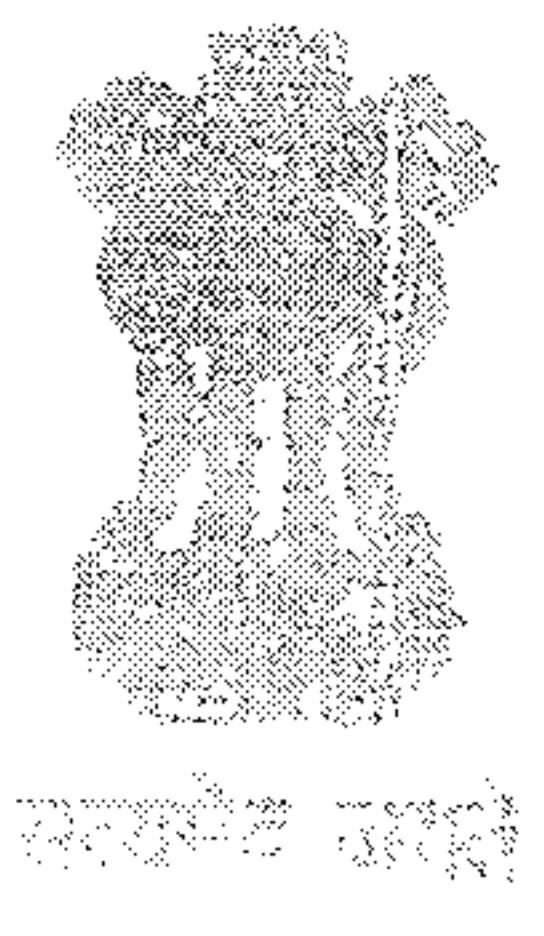
We appeal to all students to get enrolled not only themselves but also their family and community members around them under these social security schemes and thereby extend the benefits of the schemes to all

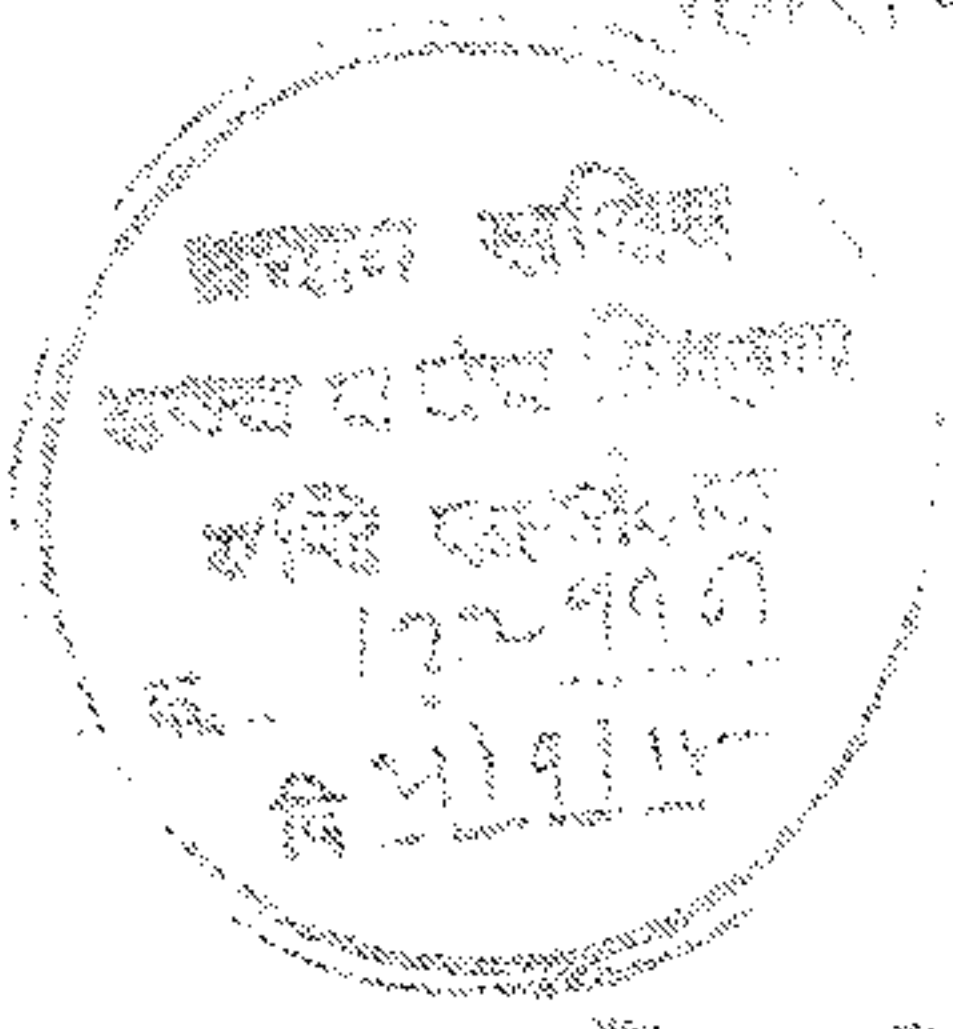

Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSSBY), Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY) and the Atal Pension Yojana (APY) recently. This initiative is aimed at fulfilling the Government's resolve to provide social security protection to all citizens including teachers in an affordable and convenient manner.

The PMSSBY offers accidental death-cum-disability insurance of ₹ 2 lakh to all bank account holders in the age group of 18-70 years for an annual premium of ₹ 12 only. The PMJJBY offers a term life insurance cover of ₹ 2 lakh for an annual premium of ₹ 330 to all bank account holders in the age group of 18-50 years. APY promotes old age income security and focuses on unorganized sector workers. It offers subscribers entering the Scheme at the age between 18 and 40 years, a Government guaranteed minimum pension per month starting at the age of 60.

The benefits accruing under these social security schemes will go a long way in building additional social security protection for the families of the teachers. The premium under PMSSBY and PMJJBY is very nominal which can be paid by the concerned beneficiary easily. The Teachers may also be encouraged to spread awareness about the Schemes and motivate others around them to enroll for these Schemes.

The Teachers' Day could be a great occasion to involve our esteemed teachers in enrolling not only themselves but also their family members and the members of communities around them under these social security schemes. I, therefore, request you to kindly issue necessary directions to the concerned authorities in your State for extending benefits of the social security schemes to all esteemed teachers and others around them wherever applicable.
